Kitchen Assistant Job Description

Job Summary

Responsible for assisting with preparation with camp meals, washing dishes and stocking dining hall supplies.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain dining hall with adequate supplies
- Assist with serving food
- Assist head cook with meal preparation
- Assist with washing dirty dishes, pots, pans and utensils
- Responsible for maintaining a safe and clean kitchen including sweeping and mopping floors and cleaning surfaces
- Assist with receiving and stocking food
- Follow all New York State Department of Health, Center for the Disabled and American Camping Association sanitation codes

Working Environment

- Works 12 hours a day for six days in a row
- Works around hot stoves/ovens for extended periods
- May reside at camp (rustic, constant community living) or off-camp
- Rustic outdoor environment/facilities
- Subject to environmental influences such as inclement weather, insects, heat, etc.

Physical Demands

- Frequent lifting of food packages and pots
- Must stand on feet for long periods
