Maintenance Worker Job Description

Job Summary

Responsible for the daily grounds keeping needs of the camp and general maintenance needs.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Responsible for emptying all garbage bins daily
- Provide general maintenance (e.g. fix screens, change light bulbs, chop wood, plunge toilets, keep rain gutters clear, etc.)
- Responsible for the general upkeep of the grounds (e.g. weeding and watering flower beds, blowing leaves, mowing and trimming grass, etc.)
- Responsible for the general upkeep of the nature trail (e.g. brush cutting, raking, etc.)
- Responsible for cleaning all camp bathrooms, changing tables, sinks, countertops, floors and toilets daily
- Responsible for stocking paper products and soap in all camp bathrooms

Working Environment

- Subject to environmental influences such as inclement weather, insects, heat, etc.
- Work with hazardous materials
- Works outdoors for long periods of time
- May reside at camp (rustic, constant community living) or off-camp
- May need to respond to facility needs at any time including unusual hours

Physical Demands

- Frequent lifting of heavy objects (50 lbs)
- Must operate manual and power tools
- Must stand on feet for long periods
